There's also a solar irrigation system, meaning your plants get watered automatically (finally—a helper who doesn't complain). For entertainers, the summer kitchen with built-in BBQ is a must-see. Whether you're grilling Dutch satay, German bratwurst, or the Great British sausage, this is where the good times live. The home is south-facing with open mountain views, and the solarium takes full advantage—perfect for sunrise coffees, sunset wine, and everything in between. The double-fronted glass curtains give you the choice between airy openness or sheltered comfort, depending on the season.
